Curaçao Art Circle and Palm Music Foundation are organizing two memorable concerts with a unique selection from the rich musical heritage from 19th century and early 20th century music from Curaçao.

You will enjoy the sparkling and virtuoso playing of the Georgian pianist Ketevan Sharumashvili (www.ketisharu.com) and the Dutch violinist Jeroen Dupont (www.jeroendupont.nl). Both top musicians have won several first prizes at international music competitions.

The concert program includes compositions by: **Jan Gerard Palm** (1831-1906), the patriarch of Curaçao classical salon music; **Jules Blasini** (1847-1887) who was the only Antillean to study at the conservatory in Paris; **Joseph Sickman Corsen** (1853-1911) the well-known poet-musician-composer; **Miguel Senior** (1877-1975) who gave recitals in his younger years on all major concert stages in Latin America and in Paris; and **Jacobo Conrad** (1879-1918) who brought touching serenades with his violin under many a bedroom window in Curaçao!
